The Arrhythmia - Heart Failure Academy, Institute of Cardiovascular Diseases, The Madras Medical Mission periodically organizes Continuing Medical Education program for physicians, cardiologists and medical students including postgraduates in Medicine, Pediatrics, Anesthesia and Critical care as well as for the residents of Cardiology superspecialty.

Basic and Advanced Electrocardiology courses are conducted twice a year. A conference on the updates of latest technology and treatment of Heart Failure and Cardiac Arrhythmia is conducted in the months of August / September every year. Live workshops on Radiofrequency Ablation (RFA) procedures and Heart Failure Device Implantations (AICD, CRT-P and CRT-D) are conducted regularly. The academy offers electrophysiology fellowship for those who have qualified DM / DNB cardiology. Also training programmes for international board of heart rhythm examiners (IBHRE) examination for competency in cardiac electrophysiology as well as cardiac device therapy are conducted every year. The academy also provides training courses for technologists who are involved in electrophysiology studies and radiofrequency ablation procedures and pacemaker follow ups.

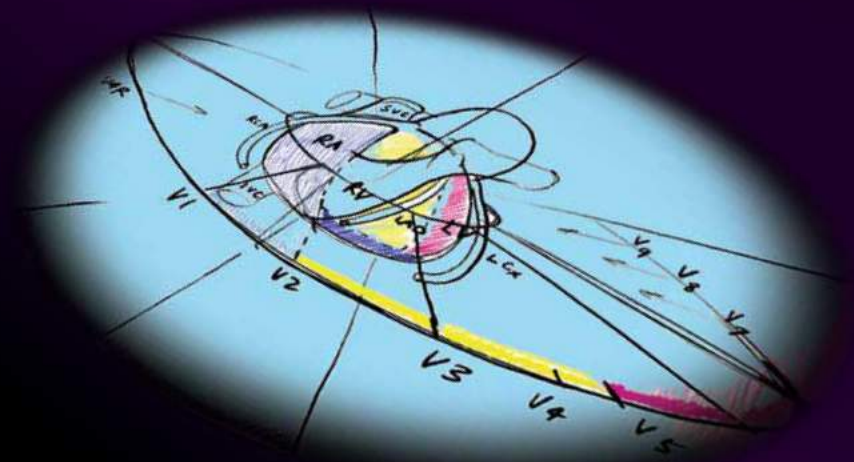
